Riverview Center is a non-profit agency committed to providing compassionate, client-centered care for individuals affected by sexual violence in Iowa and for individuals affected by sexual and domestic violence in Illinois. All of our services are free, confidential, and age-appropriate.

Since our inception, Riverview Center's primary concern has been to create a safe environment for survivors of violence, in which they know that the assault was not their fault. By providing choices, we empower survivors to decide how we can best serve their needs on their road to healing. To meet these diverse needs, Riverview Center provides the following services:

**24-Hour Hotline:** The hotline provides 24-hour access to crisis counseling, advocates to meet survivors at the hospital or to arrange for safe, temporary shelter, and information about our other services.

**Therapy/Counseling:** Our master degree counselors provide trauma focused counseling that is custom-tailored for child, adolescent, and adult survivors and significant others in individual and group settings.

**Medical Advocacy:** Advocates are available 24-hours a day to mediate interactions between the survivor, emergency room personnel, and law enforcement, to provide information about medical options, and referrals for other services.

**Legal Advocacy:** Legal advocates serve as liaisons between the survivors and the criminal justice system to ensure their rights are protected. Advocates can assist with orders of protection and accompany survivors to police interviews and court proceedings.

**Emergency Shelter:** We provide arrangements for safe, temporary shelter. This includes our temporary shelter, women's shelters in Dubuque and Platteville, and hotel room vouchers.

**Violence Prevention Education:** Riverview Center presents to tens of thousands of schoolchildren each year to foster healthy relationships and bolster self-esteem to allow them to constructively and nonviolently deal with personal stress and threats to their safety. Specialized training is also conducted for law enforcement, social service, legal and medical personnel, and parents.
